WELCOME TO XAGHRA AND ITS FEAST HIGHLIGHTS OF THE PROGRAMME Thursday 23rd August to Saturday 8th September 2018

THE FEAST:

Xaghra celebrates the feast of its Patron Saint, Maria Bambina, the Church being dedicated to the Birth of the Virgin Mary. The festivities are therefore meant to honour Our Lady, the Mother of God, on her birthday - 8th September. The Day is one of Malta's National Days and has strong historical ties. In fact, the feast day is more popularly known as "II-Vitorja" (The Victory) and the Madonna



known as **Our Lady of Victory** because important dates are attached to this day, two in particular.

In 1565, Malta was besieged by a strong army from the Ottoman Empire with the aim of establishing a base here meant to crush Christianity in Europe. The Knights of St. John of Jerusalem were governing Malta in those days, the Grand Master being the French Jean Parisot de Valette. For five months, the Maltese and the Knights held steadfastly in defence of the islands and praying the Madonna to deliver them from the enemy. When they were nearly down on their knees, on 8th September 1565, what remained of the Turkish army took to the boats and the armada left Malta's shores beaten. This is remembered as the Great Siege of 1565. The monument raised for the feast on Victory Square depicts Grand Master De Valette kneeling down and receiving the palm of Victory with the slain Turkish Admiral, Dragut, lying prostrate at his feet.

The Second World War brought to Malta another siege. For three long years Malta fought for its survival. The Italian air force was striking at the heart of the islands and bombs were falling like confetti from the air. Bombs threatened to blast out the lives and the spirit of the Maltese people and the British forces defending the island. Again, the Siege was well and truly lifted on the 8th of September when Italy ceded the war in 1943. That afternoon the titular statue of the Bambina had left the Church in procession and was still on the parvis when word spread to the relief and joy of the crowds present that for the Maltese islands the war was over and they were therefore safe.

No wonder, therefore, that annually on the 8th day of September, besides celebrating the day Our Lady was born, the islands celebrate the day when they were reborn. Beyond doubt, this happened through the intercession of Our Gracious Lady, the Bambina, as in both sieges the locals turned to her in earnest prayer. You will be hearing the call for the "Bambina" very often and this stands for the Little Newly Born Baby, the Virgin Mary.

We welcome you to enjoy the celebrations with us here in Xaghra and cordially invite you to join in the celebrations, especially where marked (*) in the programme. We wish you a Happy Feast and an enjoyable stay amongst us.
